## MEDICAL SERVICES QUALITY IMPROVEMENT ACTIVITIES

Did you know that participating in quality improvement activities can earn you continuing professional development (CPD) credits from your respective colleges?

The table below gives you an idea of the categories/sections and number of credits (certified or not) that you could claim each time that you participate in a medical services quality improvement activity.
